ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

On March 16, 2004, the Judicial Conference approved an Amendment to the District Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule, promulgated under 28 U.S.C. § 1914, requiring an increase in the fee for attorney admission to the Bars of the District Courts from \$50 to \$150. Pursuant to Local Rule 2.01(d) for the Middle District of Florida and the Guidelines and Plan for Administration of Non-Appropriated Funds of the Middle District of Florida, a \$15 attorney admission fee is also required on initial application of an attorney to become a member of the Bar of this Court. Therefore, effective June 1, 2004, the initial application fee for attorney admission shall be a total of \$165.


Attorneys admitted to the Bar of this Court before June 1, 2004, shall not be required to pay an additional attorney admission fee; however, such attorneys shall be required to pay the annual renewal fee described below in accordance with the Local Rules and Guidelines and Plan for Administration of Non-Appropriated Funds, of this Court.

Effective June 1, 2004, pursuant to the Middle District of Florida's Guidelines and Plan for Administration of Non-Appropriated Funds, an attorney appearing pro hac vice shall pay a pro hac vice fee of \$10 in each case in which an appearance in such capacity is made.

In addition, effective June 1, 2004, an annual renewal fee of \$10 shall be paid by an attorney who wishes to renew membership in the Bar of this Court. Attorneys admitted before January 1, 2004, shall pay an annual renewal fee for 2004, and attorneys admitted to the Bar of the Court on, or after, January 1, 2004, shall pay an annual renewal fee commencing in the year 2005. The deadline for payment of the annual renewal fee for 2004, as contained in the Middle District of Florida's Guidelines and Plan for Administration of Non-Appropriated Funds, shall be extended thirty calendar days to July 30, 2004. Beginning in the year 2005 the annual renewal fee shall be paid on or before the last business day in June.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that effective June 1, 2004, pursuant to the Judicial Conference's Amendment to the District Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule and the Guidelines and Plan for Administration of Non-Appropriated Funds of the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, the initial attorney admission fee shall be \$165, the pro hac vice fee shall be \$10, and the annual renewal fee shall be \$10. The deadline for payment of the annual renewal fee for 2004 shall be extended thirty calendar days to July 30, 2004. The annual renewal fee for 2005 and thereafter shall be paid on the last business day in June of the calendar year.
