## STORAGE LOCKERS FOR CELL PHONES, HAND-HELD DEVICES, & LAPTOPS IN THE FEDERAL COURTHOUSE



*The lockers will be available for use by lawyers having business in the federal courthouse starting **Monday, June 16, 2008**. The lockers are located immediately after the Court Security Officer area on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor. Although the rule remains that lawyers may not bring their cell phones, etc., to the courtrooms without court order, lawyers may bring their cell phones, etc., to the courthouse and store them in the lockers while the lawyers are in the courtrooms or on other courthouse business.*

### THESE RULES APPLY TO USE OF THE LOCKERS:

-  To use a locker, a lawyer must present a Court Security Officer with either: (1) a valid Florida Bar card; or (2) a current file-stamped copy of an order specially admitting the lawyer to practice in the Middle District of Florida .
-  Lawyers must turn-off ring tones before storing cell phones in the lockers.
-  A lawyer must pay a \$25 lost key charge if he or she loses a locker key.



By using the lockers, lawyers assume risk of theft or damage to their stored items.



The Association may deny use of the lockers to anyone who violates these rules.
