Electronic Copy Fees - Copy of an imaged page printed from public access terminal. (Docket information for all active and some closed cases is available through electronic access. See "Electronic Access" on page two.)	\$ 10
Fee for reproduction of recordings of proceedings regardless of medium. This fee shall apply to services rendered on behalf of the United States if the reproduction of the recording is available electronically.	\$ 26.00
Archived Record Retrieval Fee - For retrieval of each case record from the Federal Records Center, National Archives, or other storage location removed from the place of business of the court	\$ 45.00
For an NSF check paid into the court which is returned for lack of funds	\$ 45.00
For an appeal to a district judge from a judgment of conviction by a magistrate in a misdemeanor or petty offense case	\$ 32.00
Original attorney admission to practice (includes certificate of admission)	\$ 165.00
Pro hac vice or special admission to practice-Clerk's Office form titled "Application for Special Admission to Practice" must accompany this fee	\$ 10.00
Attorney annual renewal fee (every two years)-Attorney annual renewal fee is to be mailed, as directed, with remittance form.	\$ 20.00
