
ORDER

This cause came on for consideration upon a Joint Motion for Extension of Time (Dkt. # 612) filed by Defendants, Sami Amin Al-Arian, Sameeh Hammoudeh, and Hatim Naji Fariz. The Defendants have requested an extension of time to file objections, motions for clarification, or motions for reconsideration of the Magistrate Judge's Order of August 18, 2004 (Dkt. # 605). Among other things, this Order sets forth periodic deadlines for the Government's transfer to the Defendants of English-language transcripts that the Government intends to use at trial.

Because the Defendants do not set forth in their Motion any particular reason justifying such an extension, this Court finds that the Motion should be DENIED. It is therefore ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. Defendants' Joint Motion for Extension of Time (Dkt. # 612) is **DENIED**.
2. Defendants have until September 15, 2004, to file any objections or motions with respect to the Magistrate's Order of August 18, 2004 (Dkt. # 605).
