ORDER AS TO WITNESS ABDUL RAOUF DABUS

On motion of the United States (Dkt. #1349), and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court:

1. That Abdul Raouf Dabus may be called as a witness to testify or provide other information in the above-captioned proceeding; and
2. That in the judgment of the said United States Attorney, said witness is likely to refuse to testify or provide other information on the basis of his privilege against self-incrimination.
3. That in the judgment of the said United States Attorney, the testimony or other information from said witness may be necessary to the public interest; and
4. That the aforesaid Motion filed herein has been made with the approval of the Assistant Attorney General in charge of the Criminal Division of the Department of Justice, pursuant to the authority vested in her by 18 U.S.C. § 6003 and 28 C.F.R. § 0.175.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Said motion (Dkt. #1349) is GRANTED.

2. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 6002, the said Abdul Raouf Dabus shall give testimony or provide other information which he refuses to give or to provide on the basis of his privilege against self-incrimination as to all matters about which he may be questioned during the said proceeding and during any subsequent trials, if any, which may be related to such information and testimony. No testimony or other information compelled under this order (or any information directly or indirectly derived from such testimony or other information) may be used against him in any criminal case, except a prosecution for perjury, giving a false statement, or otherwise failing to comply with this order.

3. This order shall become effective only if after the date of this order the said witness refuses to testify or provide other information on the basis of his privilege against self-incrimination.
