ORDER

THIS MATTER is before the court on Defendant Sami Amin Al-Arian's **Motion and Memorandum of Law for Expedited Rule 16 Discovery** (Doc. 34). By this motion, filed on March 12, 2003, counsel for Dr. Al-Arian seeks an order requiring the Government to produce Rule 16 discovery by March 17, 2003.

Upon consideration, the motion to expedite discovery (Doc. 34) is **DENIED**. The court has calendared this cause for an arraignment and discovery conference on March 25, 2003. At that conference, the court will address the matter of the Government's production of the voluminous discovery comprehensively in relation to all of the defendants in this case. To the extent that Dr. Al-Arian is able to demonstrate to Magistrate Judge Mark A. Pizzo his need for specific items of discovery in the possession of the Government for use at the detention hearing, he may seek appropriate redress from Judge Pizzo during the hearing.
