ORDER

This cause came on for consideration without oral argument upon the Notice of Appeal (Dkt. #84) filed by Defendant, Sameeh Hammoudeh. It is unclear from the "Notice of Appeal" whether Defendant is actually seeking review of the magistrate's Order (Dkt. #74) that detained him pending trial of this matter. This Court has jurisdiction to review a detention order pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3145(b). Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3145(b), this Court is to review a detention order promptly. Defendant's motion does not provide any detail or argument on the grounds for review. If Defendant is seeking review, Defendant shall file within **seven (7) days** of this Order a more thorough motion and memorandum, providing argument and the grounds for seeking review. Failure by Defendant to do so will result in this Court striking his Notice of Appeal (Dkt. #84).
