ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the court on Mr. Al-Arian's **Motion to Require Immediate Production of All Discovery Material Referred (sic) to in the Indictment in Their Entirety (Doc. 183)** and the **United States' Motion to Strike or, in the Alternative, Opposition to Defendant Al-Arian's Motion to Require Immediate Production of All Discovery Material Referred to in the Indictment in Their Entirety (Doc. 177)**.


Additionally, the government has provided a copy of an August 1, 2003, letter to Mr. Al-Arian and defense counsel in further response to the motion. Upon consideration, insofar as the government seeks to strike the motion, its motion (Doc. 177) is **DENIED**. The Defendant's **Motion to Require Immediate Production of All Discovery Material Referred (sic) to in the Indictment in Their Entirety (Doc. 183)** is **DENIED** without prejudice. Based on the government's letter of August 1, 2003, the government appears to have adequately cured the sundry complaints made by Mr. Al-Arian regarding the completeness and quality of the audio tapes previously provided to all defendants. Insofar as the motion requests discovery of

facsimiles, documents, video tapes, and financial documents, such discovery is available for all defendants' viewing. Since most of such documents are maintained in their original form, the court intends to follow the existing plan for the defendants and counsel to view the discovery at the offices of the F.B.I. in Tampa. At present, the bank records and evidence from searches are available at this location. Where necessary and appropriate, arrangements can be made for copying or scanning of such discovery.
