ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the court on **Defendant Sami Amin Al-Arian's Emergency Pro Se Motion Seeking Clarification of its Recent Order of August 28, 2003** (Doc. 260). By his motion, Defendant claims that he has been precluded from having contact visits with his "legal advisors." *Id.* at 2. According to Defendant, the administrators at Coleman FCC, where Defendant is housed as a pretrial detainee, recently have prevented him from contact visits with attorneys as a result of the court's order dated August 28, 2003 (Doc. 240). *Id.*

Prior to ruling on this motion, the court needs additional information. The Defendant is directed to file a response to this order within ten (10) days. In his response, Defendant shall identify the legal advisors with whom he seeks contact visits and state the nature of the legal business each is handling for the Defendant. Accordingly, the ruling on Defendant's motion (Doc. 260) is DEFERRED.
