NOTICE

On September 26, 2013 this Court modified its policy concerning the possession and use of personal electronic devices in the courthouses located in the Middle District of Florida. While this policy permits attorneys and jurors, with valid identification, to possess and use electronic devices in the courthouses of the Middle District of Florida, it remains the policy of the undersigned to prohibit cell phones in the courtroom. This prohibition also applies to Assistant United States Attorneys and Federal Public Defenders.

Therefore, be advised that cell phones will not be permitted in proceedings in any courtroom in the Middle District of Florida over which the undersigned is presiding. Cell phones may be placed in the receptacles located in the witness room outside Courtroom 4A, or in the secure location located on the first floor of the Courthouse.
