**Public Notice**

**Readmission to the Middle District of Florida Bar**

Local Rule 2.01, Middle District of Florida, sets forth the requirements for general admission to practice before the Court. Local Rule 2.01(c) specifies that:

Petitions for general admission to practice shall be called from time to time in open Court on notice to the applicants; except that, under special circumstances, any United States District Judge or United States Magistrate Judge of the Court may entertain a petition at any time. Upon taking the prescribed oath and payment of the prescribed enrollment fee, the applicant shall then be enrolled as a member of the bar of the Court and the Clerk shall issue a suitable certificate to that effect.

Local Rule 2.01(d) specifies, in part, that:

An attorney who fails to pay timely the periodic fee or fails without exemption to maintain a registered e-mail address is subject to removal from the membership in the bar of this Court.

An attorney whose membership lapses pursuant to Local Rule 2.01(d), is required to reapply for admission to the Middle District of Florida Bar and pay the current fee for attorney admission. **If an attorney applying for readmission has previously attended a MDFL Attorney Admissions Ceremony, that attorney may be sworn in telephonically and is not required to attend another ceremony.** Please visit the Attorney Admission section of the Court's website [www.flmd.uscourts.gov](http://www.flmd.uscourts.gov) for directions on scheduling a telephonic admissions ceremony.
