ORDER

This cause came on for consideration without oral argument on the following motion filed herein:

**MOTION: UNITED STATES' UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR AN
ORDER FOR A MENTAL EXAMINATION OF
DEFENDANT PURSUANT TO FED. R. CRIM. P.
12.2(C)(1)(B) (Doc. No. 79)**

Counsel for the Defendant has represented to the Court that Defendant intends to introduce expert evidence relating to Defendant's mental condition bearing on the issue of guilt as provided for in Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 12.2(b). Counsel for the United States now seeks authority to conduct an examination of Defendant provided for in Rule 12.2(c)(1)(B). It is **ORDERED** that the request is **GRANTED**.

It is further **ORDERED** that the United States may cause a psychiatric or psychological examination of Defendant be conducted by a suitably licensed psychologist or psychiatrist. Upon agreement of the parties, counsel for the Defendant will not be permitted to attend the examination. The examining psychologist or psychiatrist may use audio or video recording for all or portions of the examination if he or she deems it appropriate to do so in the expert's professional judgment and pursuant to the expert's common practice.

The motion suggests that counsel for Defendant may request other limitations on the examination by separate motion. The Court ordered that a motion regarding “the proposed limitations of such examination” be filed on or before July 31, 2017. Doc. No. 74. The time for filing a motion asking for additional limitations on the United States’ examination of the Defendant has passed, and no motion has been filed. Accordingly, no further limitations on the examination are imposed on the expert for the United States.

Counsel for the United States shall provide a copy of this Order to its examining expert.
