STANDING ORDER

In accordance with Local Rule 1.01(b) of the Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida (“**Local Rules**”), it is **ORDERED** that in all proceedings before the undersigned, all objections to an order or report and recommendation issued by a United States Magistrate Judge shall include—in a single document no longer than fifteen pages inclusive of all parts—a concise statement of the precise basis for the objection, a legal memorandum supporting the objection, and the precise relief that the objector seeks to obtain. The opposing party may file a legal memorandum in opposition to the objection—not to exceed ten pages inclusive of all parts—within fourteen days after service of the objection. Failure to strictly adhere to these page limitations and requirements may result in the summary denial of the objection without notice.
