## ORDER CONCERNING TEMPERATURE CHECKS IN THE BRYAN SIMPSON UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE

This Order applies to the Bryan Simpson United States Courthouse in Jacksonville, Florida, and supplements the courthouse protocols in the Court's June 16, 2020 Order (Doc. 2), the terms of which remain in full force and effect. This Order also serves to enforce the Order entered July 9, 2020 in Case No. 8:20-mc-20-T-24 (Doc. 3), IN RE: Restrictions on Visitors to the United States Courthouses in the Middle District of Florida, which Order is incorporated by reference. These Orders are in place to protect health and safety during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Effective immediately, each visitor entering the Bryan Simpson United States Courthouse must submit to a temperature check by pausing before a standalone infrared temperature scanner that detects a fever equal to or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit. Law enforcement officers, protective service officers, and court security officers working for the Federal Protective Service and the U.S. Marshals Service shall enforce this Order and will deny entry to persons refusing to submit to a temperature check and to anyone registering a fever equal to or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit. Any visitor denied entry due to this Order should contact the office to be visited for assistance in determining what other arrangements or accommodations can be made to accomplish the business needs of the visitor without entry into the building. Court Security Officers may also contact the duty Magistrate Judge for assistance.
