The panel must review Magistrate Judge Irick's performance and comments received in response to the public notice of reappointment, and the panel may interview Magistrate Judge Irick. No later than **December 8**, **2023**, the panel must recommend to the Court whether to reappoint Magistrate Judge Irick for another term. The Court has notified each panel member in writing of the one-year restriction on a panel member's applying for a magistrate judgeship. *See Guide to Judiciary Policy*, Vol. 3, Ch. 4, § 420.30.20(d).

The Clerk of Court must publish notice of the Middle District of Florida's consideration of the reappointment and shall assist the panel as needed.
