ORDER EXTENDING CJA PANELS UNTIL APRIL 30, 2024

Every three years under 18 U.S.C. § 3006A and Section 1.04(c)(2) of the Middle District of Florida's Criminal Justice Act (CJA) Plan, the Board of Judges appoints each division's CJA panel. The CJA panel reapplication process is currently set to begin at the end of 2022, and the CJA panels are set to be reappointed on April 30, 2023. During the COVID-19 pandemic, CJA lawyers have had fewer appointments and opportunities to appear in court. Because of these extenuating circumstances, and with the approval of the Board of Judges, the Middle District's current CJA panels are extended for twelve months, until April 30, 2024, so that lawyers can have additional time and practice before their required CJA reapplication.
