# Middle District of Florida Tampa Q-SYS Upgrades Statement of Work (SOW)



### 1.1 Introduction:

The U.S. District Court, Middle District of Florida (MDFL), is a federal district court with the Clerk of the Court's office headquarters located in Orlando and divisional offices in Tampa, Jacksonville, Fort Myers, and Ocala.

The MDFL would like to continue an in-house project of replacing our audio/video systems in the courtroom located in Tampa. The court would like to partner with an integration firm for the procurement of the necessary hardware to carry out its intended AV integration project.

# 1.2 Objectives:

The MD/FL is asking for specific pricing of the following "Bid Sheet." All items included on the bid sheet should be fully sealed, in brand new condition, and come with the standard manufacturer's warranty. All items should match the described product specification and model number. Any product substitution(s) must be implicitly approved by the project COTR and signed off on by CO.

This procurement is for <u>hardware/equipment only</u>. The MDFL Systems department will conduct all installation, integration, and support services of equipment. This bid specification is strictly for the procurement of hardware items as listed on the bid sheet.
