ORDER

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court upon the Government's Application for Court Order to modify the Forfeiture of Collateral Schedule for laws and regulations enforced by the United States Department of Interior, United States Fish and Wildlife Service, Office of Law Enforcement.

This Order supersedes all earlier Orders establishing in the Middle District of Florida a plan known as the Forfeiture of Collateral System for the United States Department of Interior, United States Fish and Wildlife Service, Office of Law Enforcement. From the date of this Order all forfeitures of collateral on petty offenses shall be handled in accordance with the schedule attached to this Order.

Under this plan, collateral may be posted in lieu of the personal appearance of a person charged with certain petty offenses under the laws and/or regulations of the United States. Upon the failure of the person charged with a petty offense violation to appear before the United States Magistrate Judge for trial of the offense, collateral in the appropriate amount, as shown on the attached schedule, shall be forfeited to the United States and serve as the fine for said offense. The posting of collateral shall signify that the

person does not contest the charge or request a hearing. Forfeiture of collateral shall constitute an admission of guilt.

Nothing herein shall prohibit a United States Magistrate Judge, or law enforcement officer, from requiring the personal appearance of the person accused before the Magistrate Judge, whether the offense to be charged appears in the schedule or does not appear.

Offenses for which collateral may be posted in lieu of appearance and the amount of said collateral shall be as shown on the schedule of violations and fines attached hereto.

WILDLIFE/PROPERTY FORFEITURE ORDER

Unless otherwise specifically ordered by the United States Court for the Middle District of Florida, any wildlife or property which has been seized within the jurisdiction of the Middle District of Florida under the authority of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, 16 USC 703-711; the Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act, 16 USC 718-718i; the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act, 16 USC 668dd-668ee; the Endangered Species Act, 16 USC 1531-1542; the Marine Mammal Protection Act, 16 USC 1361-1407; the Eagle Protection Act, 16 USC 668-668d; the Tariff Classification Act, 19 USC 1202; the Airborne Hunting Act, 16 USC 742j-l; the Rhinoceros and Tiger Conservation Act, 16 USC 5301-5305a; the Antiquities Act, 16 USC 433; the Lacey Act Amendments of 1981, 16 USC 3371-3378; the Lacey Act 18 USC 42; the African Elephant Conservation Act, 16 USC 4223 or the Wild Exotic Bird Conservation Act, 16 USC 4910, where final disposition of the case had been made by either payment of a forfeiture of collateral or a judgment by the Court on behalf of the Government and where so authorized by statute, such wildlife or property shall be forfeited to the U.S. Government and disposed of by the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service in such a manner as described by Title 50, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 12.
