**ORDER**


By previous Order entered April 17, 2009, the Court acknowledged that the term of office of United States Magistrate Judge Thomas B. McCoun III will expire on January 31, 2010 and directed the Clerk of Court to give public notice of the pending reappointment of the incumbent Magistrate Judge. The Order also appointed a Merit Selection Panel pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 631(b)(5) and the regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States set forth in The Selection and Appointment of United States Magistrate Judges (October 1997).

By report of the Merit Selection Panel dated July 10, 2009, the Merit Selection Panel has unanimously recommended that Thomas B. McCoun III, the incumbent United States Magistrate Judge, be reappointed for an additional term. On appropriate motion, the recommendation of the Merit Selection Panel was unanimously approved by the District Court Judges on July 24, 2009.

Accordingly, United States Magistrate Judge Thomas B. McCoun III is hereby reappointed for a term of eight (8) years commencing upon the expiration of his present term of office on January 31, 2010.
