ORDER

Under 28 U.S.C. § 631(b)(5) and the policies of the Judicial Conference of the United States, a merit selection panel is established to consider the re-appointment of Magistrate Judge Thomas G. Wilson in Tampa, Florida. The panel is effective July 30, 2018, and comprises:

- Maruchi Azorin (layperson)
- Jenay Iurato (lawyer)
- Steven Oscher (layperson)
- The Honorable E.J. Salcines (lawyer)
- Jason Stearns (lawyer)
- Jack Townsend, Sr. (lawyer)

The panel must review Judge Wilson's performance and comments received in response to the public notice of re-appointment, and the panel may interview Judge Wilson. No later than October 26, 2018, the panel must recommend to the district judges whether to re-appoint Judge Wilson for another term. A July 30, 2018 letter notifies each panel member of Section 420.30.20(d), *Guide to Judiciary Policy*, the one-year restriction on a panel member's applying for a magistrate judgeship.

The Clerk of Court must publish the notice of re-appointment and must assist the panel as needed.
