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**ORDER**

This matter comes before the Court on the “Joint Notice of Discovery Status as of May 5, 2022” (the “Joint Notice”). [Doc. No. 115](#). In the Joint Notice, two issues warrant briefing by the parties. The first is whether the parties should share the cost to complete the required data anonymization for twenty studies. *Id.* at 6-7. The second is whether the discovery deadline should be extended due to the estimated timeline for producing the data for the twenty studies and the lack of an estimated timeline for the Argus production. *Id.* at 8-9.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. **On or before May 13, 2022**, NPC must file a brief regarding whether the parties should share the cost to complete the required data anonymization for twenty studies and Plaintiffs must file a brief regarding whether the discovery deadline should be extended due to the estimated timeline for producing the data for the twenty studies and the lack of an estimated timeline for the Argus production;

2. **On or before May 16, 2022**, the parties must file briefs in opposition to the briefs described in the above paragraph; and
3. The supporting briefs must comply with the page requirements in Local Rule 3.01(a) and the opposing briefs must comply with the page requirements in Local Rule 3.01(b). The parties are directed to continue to meet their obligations to meet and confer in good faith as to these issues so that the briefing and resolution of these matters will be meaningful.
