PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 4

The third status conference for this matter was held on Monday, December 6, 2021. (Doc. 70.) This Order memorializes the Court's oral pronouncements at that hearing.

The deadline for Defendant's production of the first grouping of documents is **RESET** to Friday, January 7, 2022. The deadline for the production of the Plaintiff Fact Sheets is **RESET** to Friday, January 7, 2022.

The parties are **GRANTED** leave to submit a motion seeking the entry of a Federal Rule of Evidence 502(d) order. Defendant is **DENIED** leave to file a motion for reconsideration of the Court's order denying its motion for judgment on the pleadings, given Defendant's failure to articulate a basis under <u>Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 60(b)</u>. But Defendant is **GRANTED** leave to submit a motion seeking certification of that issue to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit under <u>Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54</u>, so long as Defendant has colorable grounds for doing so.

The next status conference in this matter will be held on **Tuesday**, **February 1, 2022**, **at 1:30 p.m.** in person in Courtroom 4A of the Orlando Federal Courthouse. Nonspeaking parties and counsel may appear via telephone; a call-in number will be provided by separate order. Lead and liaison counsel are **DIRECTED** to meet and confer on a joint proposed agenda, which is due on **Friday**, **January 21, 2022**.
