**PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 4**

The third status conference for this matter was held on Monday, December 6, 2021. ([Doc. 70](#).) This Order memorializes the Court's oral pronouncements at that hearing.

The deadline for Defendant's production of the first grouping of documents is **RESET** to Friday, January 7, 2022. The deadline for the production of the Plaintiff Fact Sheets is **RESET** to Friday, January 7, 2022.

The parties are **GRANTED** leave to submit a motion seeking the entry of a Federal Rule of Evidence 502(d) order. Defendant is **DENIED** leave to file a motion for reconsideration of the Court's order denying its motion for judgment on the pleadings, given Defendant's failure to articulate a basis under [Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 60\(b\)](#). But Defendant is **GRANTED** leave to submit a motion seeking certification of that issue to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit under [Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54](#), so long as Defendant has colorable grounds for doing so.

The next status conference in this matter will be held on **Tuesday, February 1, 2022, at 1:30 p.m.** in person in Courtroom 4A of the Orlando Federal Courthouse. Nonspeaking parties and counsel may appear via telephone; a call-in number will be provided by separate order. Lead and liaison counsel are **DIRECTED** to meet and confer on a joint proposed agenda, which is due on **Friday, January 21, 2022.**
