**PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 8**

A status conference for this matter was held recently. ([Doc. 181.](#)) This Order memorializes the Court's oral pronouncements at that hearing and resolves other matters.

The parties are **DIRECTED** to submit the deposition transcripts from the first two case-specific depositions taken in this matter (scheduled for December 21, 2022, and January 13, 2023) to the Undersigned's Chambers email<sup>1</sup> for the Court's review. The parties should order these transcripts on an expedited basis and submit each of them immediately upon receipt.

Plaintiffs' request for clarification as to the scope of case-specific motions for summary judgment previously permitted by the Court is **GRANTED**. ([Doc. 190.](#)) Those motions are limited to the learned intermediary defense only, consistent with the limited discovery permitted.

As to the parties' indication that they intend to seek leave to depose multiple

prescribing physicians in a particular case, the parties may file such motions for Magistrate Judge Baker's consideration. (Doc. 186, pp. 2-3.) That said, the parties are cautioned that such motions are discouraged and should set forth good cause for these additional depositions.

As to the parties' disagreement over member cases in which estate papers are in process for deceased plaintiffs, the parties are granted leave to file motions seeking Magistrate Judge Baker's resolution of that issue, if they cannot resolve it without the Court's assistance. (*Id.* at 3 n.1.)

The mediation deadline is **RESET to Monday, January 23, 2023.**

The next status conference in this matter is set for **Tuesday, January 31, 2023, at 10:00 a.m.**
