DRESS CODE

You are expected to conduct yourself with reserve and courtesy, and when appearing at the courthouse, must dress appropriately to preserve the dignity of the court. It is recommended that you bring a sweater or light jacket due to the relatively cool temperature of the courtroom.



ATTENTION

- You are NOT ALLOWED to bring cell phones, laptops, electronic devices, iPads/tablets, e-books, sound/video recording devices, photographic/broadcasting equipment, e-cigarettes, lighters, matches, or any objects that may activate the metal detectors in the courthouse. Wearable technology, such as smart glasses, watches, or bracelets with Internet, cellular, or Bluetooth capability, is also prohibited. You are not permitted to bring them into the building.
- All individuals entering the building are required to proceed through a security checkpoint and have any bags, packages, purses, etc. examined through an x-ray machine.
- A **valid photo ID** is required to enter the courthouse.
